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PURPOSE

To define the requirements to be a member of DIFR.

SCOPE

PROCEDURE

DIFR is an organization that uses volunteers to complete its mission. DIFR recruits members throughout the spectrum of our population as long as the member meets the initial and ongoing requirements of DIFR. The initial requirements for a new members are:

- An complete application
- Credentials verified
- Background check
- Interview with a Chief Officer
- Assignment to a mentor
- Complete NIMS 100 and 700
- Other evaluation as determined by the AHJ.

Once a new member is approved appropriate PPE, uniform, access to online library and communication gear will be issued. Additional education and duties will be outlined by the Fire/EMS Chief and the member's mentor.

Ongoing requirements for membership are:

- Representing DIFR in a positive light to the public in a professional manner.
- Attend 80% of monthly meetings*.
- Attend 80% of training for their job class*.
- Attend 100% of required training as determined by the AHJ*.

** it is the responsibility of the member to arrange for making up for missed meetings and training*

A member of DIFR may be removed from the organization with a 70% vote of the membership. Cause for removal includes unprofessional conduct, dangerous practices in training or in service, or other circumstance that endanger life and health.
