Response

- DIFR will respond with one engine to determine the magnitude of the incident.
- The OIC shall request more resources if needed. Some of the resources may include oil dry, absorbent pads, pig, PPE, etc
- If the incident is beyond DIFR's ability to manage it the IC will contact EMA through "FIREALARM" and request a specialized Haz Mat Response Team. The following information shall be conveyed with the request.
 - IC contact information
 - Type of materials if known
 - Any measures taken so far
 - A note pad to take down some pre arrival advice
